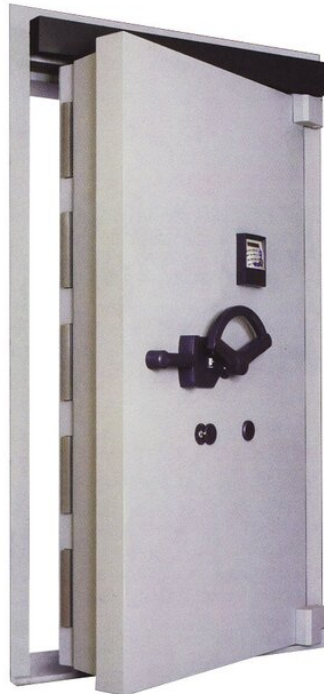

Fichet-Bauché Vault Doors and Strong Rooms - Certified protection for high-risk environments

Fichet-Bauché offers a premium range of vault doors and strong rooms, engineered to protect critical zones against the most advanced physical attacks. Models such as Optura and Optema are certified according to EN 1143-1, available in Grades V to XI/E, and optionally fire-resistant up to 120 minutes (NT Fire 017).

Doors can be installed as built-in or modular units, and combined with matching certified wall panels. Each unit features a multi-layered barrier structure with advanced reinforcement, as well as core drill protection to resist diamond drilling tools.

All vault doors are fitted with two EN 1300 certified locks, which can include mechanical combination locks, electronic code locks (e.g. KelNet), or proprietary Fichet-Bauché locking systems such as MxB or M3B. Alarm system integration is standard.

With certified burglary and fire resistance, proprietary boltwork, and reinforced protection against modern attack tools, Fichet-Bauché vault doors provide reliable, high-grade security for banks, government institutions, and high-security facilities.
