The Fichet-Bauche MC4 mechanical combination lock was developed as the successor to the older Fichet-Bauche C2C lock. While the knob looks similar in design, the internal mechanism has been completely redesigned. The MC4 is a simplified version of the Fichet-Bauche Moneo lock, featuring four dials instead of seven.

Operation is highly user-friendly. The code consists of four digits (0-12), entered via precise, tactile clicks. This makes the lock easy to operate even in the dark or by visually impaired users. When opening, the digits are automatically erased: the dials return to zero (automatic scrambling of the code), ensuring the combination is never left visible.

Certified to EN 1300 Class A, ECB-S and A2P Class 1, the MC4 is frequently combined with a Fichet-Bauche MxB-B key lock in models such as Carena, Millium and Helios. It offers a secure and durable solution for a wide range of safe and cabinet applications.
