Fichet-Bauche KelNet - high-performance electronic network locks

The KelNet lock from Fichet-Bauche combines robust security with modular flexibility: suitable for stand-alone use or as part of a fully distributed security system. It is the first electronic lock certified for distributed systems according to EN 1300 (B, C and D) by A2P and ECB-S - thus meeting the most stringent insurance standards

Typical applications

KelNet is particularly suitable for retail, jewelers, banks, public institutions, cash centers and CIT companies - anywhere where traceability, strict access control and centralized management are crucial. the KelNet lock is applicable to safes and vault rooms up to Euro class XIII.

Why choose KelNet?

- Up to 99 users + biometrics: identify users via PIN and/or optional fingerprint (up to 25 biometric users), with three hierarchical access levels (Super Manager, Manager, Operator).
- Flexible time functions & One-Time Codes (OTC): program opening times, timelocks, permanent closing periods and OTCs for CIT or maintenance personnel. All codes can be managed centrally via USB or (IP gateway).
- Extensive audit & networking capabilities: record up to 9,000 events with date/time, viewable on terminal, USB or via IP. Locks can be managed in networks of up to 16 units via up to 4 terminals + IP-Box gateway. Furthermore, I/O interfaces are available for alarm systems, duress codes and logical

links.

What sets KelNet apart?

- First distributed-systems certification: unique EN 1300-certified for network use in Class B, C and D (A2P & ECB-S).
- Secure communication & code encryption: user codes are encrypted, hardware authenticated, and upon detection of tampering, all keys are erased.
- User-friendly terminal design: spacious screen (256×128) with icons and clear text minimizes training and makes operation intuitive.

Field of use:

This safe lock is certified according to EN 1300 Class B, C or D and is suitable for installation on safes and vaultdoors up to Eurograde XIII according to EN 1143-1.
